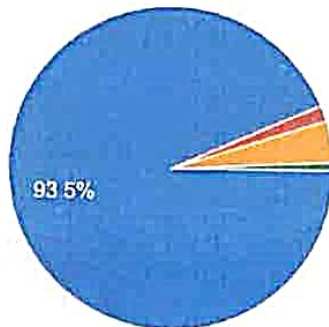

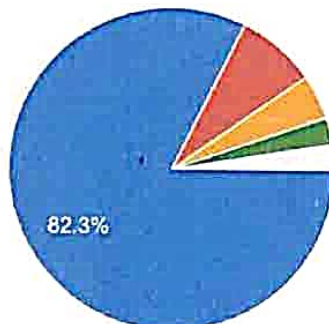

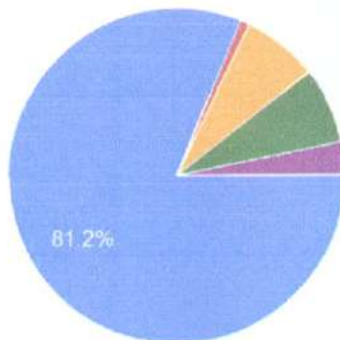

Use of Online platforms

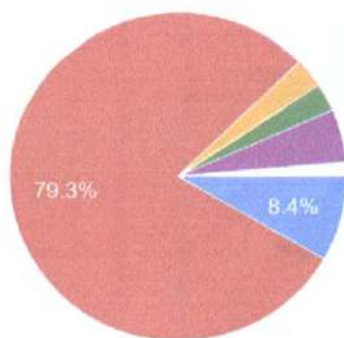

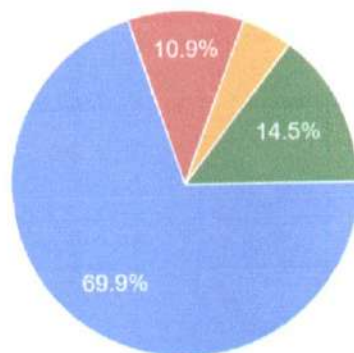

On a scale of 1 to 10 how do you rate your overall satisfaction with Dr.B.N.College of Architecture students and the curriculum ?

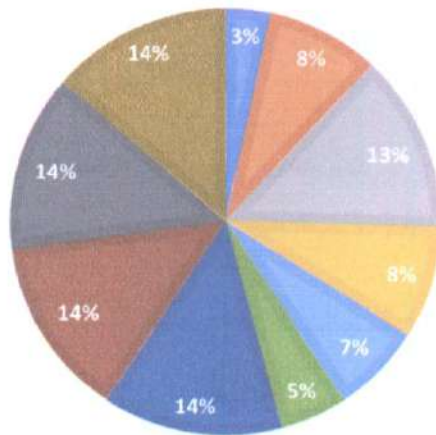

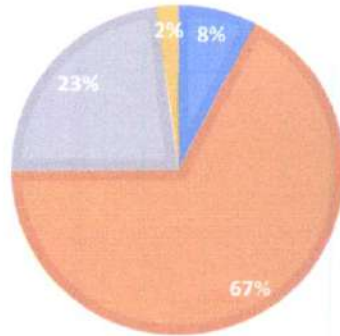

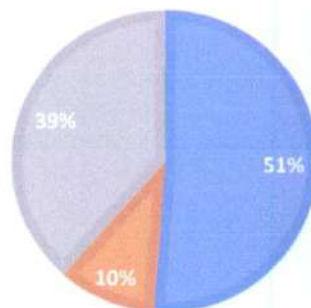
How will you rate the current Architectural education curriculum?

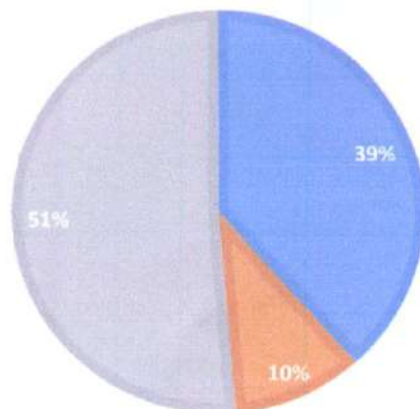
Do you think current curriculum is helpful in the practice or profession?

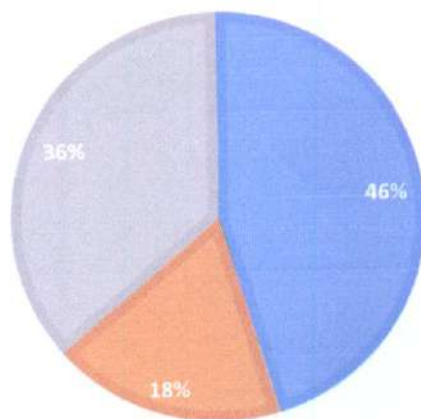
