



The 2nd prize winner Samiksha Bhosle presented 'Welcome to Bhutan' and 3rd Prize winner Janhavi Karnavar titled her entry as 'Sky above- Earth below- Peace in between'

The awards were presented by renowned wildlife photographer Vidya Kulkarni. In a function held at Shubharambh Lawns, DP Road, Erandwane, Pune on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2023 Saturday from 12.30 to 5.30 pm with a walkthrough exhibition on Wildlife and nature photographs clicked by women.

Vanaja Club, started in 2014 with the encouragement of Dr. Anurag Kashyap, Principal, BNCA and with the efforts of Prof. Asmita Joshi as the head.

Prof. Asmita reviewed the work of the last nine years in her introductory speech. It details lectures, discussions, field trips and environmental studies for students on forest awareness. BNCA students cut the birthday cake of the organization to mark the ninth anniversary of Vanja Club. On this occasion, Sanjay Deshpande, a nature lover and a construction professional working on wildlife, Hemangi Vartak of Jungle Bells organization, Anuj Khare of Naturewalk organization, Sunil Limaye, retired Chief Conservator of Forests of Maharashtra state and Amita Deshpande, who works in the Zero Waste Initiative for Forestry, also shared her thoughts.

Organizations such as Jungle Bells and Sanjeevan Group also participated in this event. On  $11^{\rm th}$  March, Saturday, from 10.30 AM to 12.30 PM a talk session was organized titled Experiences of a Wildlife Filmmaker & Wildlife Photographers with 3 resource persons, all women.

Vidya Kulkarni, a female photographer, wildlife researcher Shobha Karnik and Akanksha Trivedi, a film director working on wildlife and environment, narrated their experiences. Hemangi Vartak of Jungle Belles said that around 500 women and girls participated in the photo exhibition. Vidya Kulkarni, who picked up a camera for the first time at the age of 63, said that while cultivating the technique and aesthetics of the camera, she started taking pictures from the camera by learning herself. More than 300 self- taken photographs of birds have been collected so far, from the migratory rohit bird that comes to the beach in Mumbai area to the bulbul of Goa, the wild bird of the Western Ghats, and the waterfowl of Uttarakhand and the Himalayas. He also said that he has written extensively on bird life in Marathi and English on that occasion. Akanksha Trivedi, who made a documentary on wildlife, narrated her experiences on forest roads, wild animals.

MKSSS's BNCA's Building Emergency Evacuation Operation Committee has Scheduled its first Lecture on "Emergency Evacuation Awareness and Preparedness" followed by a safety system demonstration on 2nd March 2023, Thursday from 2:30 to 04:00pm at the BNCA Auditorium.

The director of this committee at BNCA is Prof. Yash Joshi. Evacuation wardens are Prof. Neil Kolhatkar, Prof. Ninad Jog ans Prof. Anupama Khatavkar. The administrative support persons are Mrs. Harshada Gadgil and Mr. Atul Bhalekar.

The Objective of this event was to make students aware about Emergency Evacuation Awareness and Preparedness. The Guest Speaker was Mr. Ashish Pawar, a retired army personnel.

Emergency evacuation is the urgent immediate escape of people away from an area that contains an imminent threat, an ongoing threat or a hazard to lives or property. Emergency evacuation plans are developed to ensure the safest and most efficient evacuation time of all expected residents of a structure, city, or region. The first decision during a workplace emergency is whether the occupants should stay inside or evacuate the building. Any danger inside the building, from fire to a toxic chemical spill, necessitate an immediate

evacuation. To ensure occupants safe arrival outside the building best practice is to have a clearly defined and well practiced evacuation plan in place.

All the above points were well covered in the session with a demonstration at the end.

#### Bamboo and Tensile Joint Workshop BNCA with Allana College of Architecture

A bamboo and tensile structure hands on workshop was conducted at BNCA, jointly by Prof Sayali Andhare BNCA and Prof. Vinish Desai of Allana COA from 11th March to 13th March 2023. The participants were students of both BNCA and Allana COA.

The workshop commenced with an introduction to the various types of bamboo installations, joineries, and the advantages of using bamboo as a construction material. A theory session on bamboo as a wonder grass was conducted in the seminar hall by Prof. Sayali Andhare. The participants were then taught how to use different machines like drilling machine, hacksaw, wood cutting machine and an axe. They were also taught and instructed to make columns for the structure using these machines.

On the second day of the workshop, the participants were taught how to make trusses and how to dig the foundation. They also learned how to install the columns in the appropriate way.

On the last day of the workshop on 13th March, Monday, the participants assembled the entire structure, which was an exciting experience. A session on tensile structures and the use of tensile fabrics was taken by Prof. Vinish Desai of Allana College of Architecture. 'Tensile structure' was an important and inseparable part of the workshop. A tensile installation was combined with the hands on installation of the bamboo structure. The participants learned how to put the tensile fabric in place to complete the structure. Overall, the bamboo workshop provided a comprehensive understanding of bamboo construction, including the different types of installations and joineries. The participants also gained practical knowledge by using machines and making columns and trusses. The workshop concluded with the assembly of the entire structure.

The workshop was an excellent opportunity to learn about sustainable and eco-friendly building practices.

#### Edutech Session with Ar. Sujay Ghorpadkar

The Edutech session was held on 29th March 2023, Wednesday in BNCA Auditorium, from 3:00 to 5.00 pm. This lecture was compulsory for third and fourth year students.

Ar. Sujay is the director of Bangalore based firm Opus Architects and interior design firm Vyuhana Projects.

He conducted the session by showcasing three of his projects. He explained how it started with convincing the client about using structural steel and the humangous amount of exploratory sketches and meticulous detailing that went into all the projects.

One project was of proflex roofing systems and second was of a steel diagrid structural system for a part of the structure. The third project dealt with composite steel arches as a

structural system. The session was interactive and students responded very well.

The Jaipur Settlement Study Exhibition by third-year studio A students was held at the ground floor of BNCA premises from 28th March, 2023- 4th April, 2023. It promises to be an insightful and engaging journey through the architectural landscape of Jaipur, showcasing the studio work.
