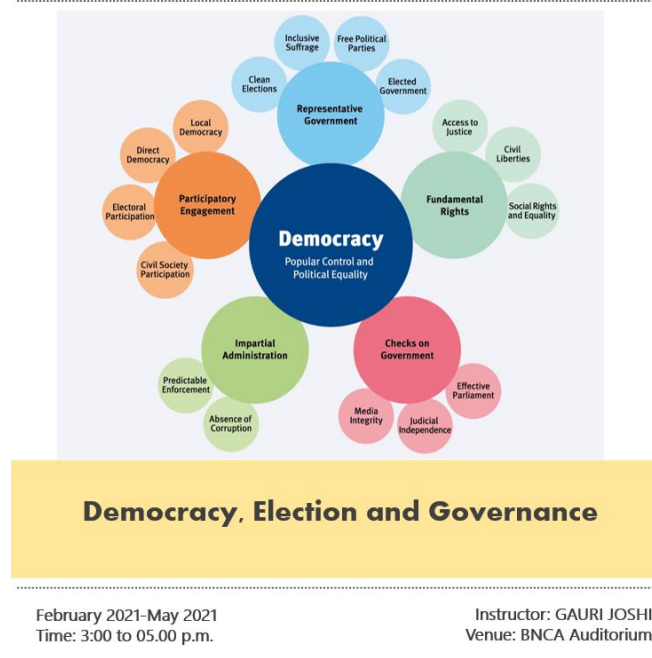

In this lecture, we learned about the laws, its significance and its usage and brushing up on the basics of civics learned in the previous years. The lecture started with an in-depth discussion over the previously learned laws and its types and it was followed by understanding the difference between few important terminologies such as Bylaws, Acts and Guidelines and how different they are from one another.

Difference between Rules and Laws:
Rules are personal in nature, and they are often adjusted as the conditions and circumstances change. Laws must be passed through due process in order to take effect.

We also learned the four sets of administration through various real life examples which made it easy for us to understand.

The four sets of laws are as follows:

- Sub standard law and procedure law.
- Civil law and criminal law
- Public law and private law
- National and international law

We also discussed about the constitution in detail and at the end of the lecture it was quite clear that all laws are not a part and parcel of the constitution, they are independent, and it must be in the accordance of the principles of the constitution.

In this lecture, we discussed the human rights, fundamental rights, constitutional rights, and statutory rights. Rights and Responsibility go hand in hand.

- Human rights:
 - These are the most basic rights and are internationally acceptable
- Fundamental rights:
 - No Human Being is a slave of the another
 - One can delegate rights but to avoid someone to regulate someone else, some rights are reserved for ourselves and are called fundamental rights.
 - These rights include the Right to life, Right to equality etc.
 - Article 14: Right to Equality.
 - Article 19: Freedom and Liberty of Speech and Expression.
 - Right to Information is also a fundamental right.
 - The right asks the authorities to mandatorily release environmental report of an area.
 - Article 21: Right to Life.
 - Life – this right includes the right to potable water, education, shelter, etc
 - Writ (Royal Prerogative) Jurisdiction – Right to go to higher courts in case certain rights are denied.
 - Public interest litigations allows one to submit pension in behalf of someone else
 - Statutory Rights

What is information: Any material in any form, includes records, documents, memos, emails, opinions, advices, press releases, circulars, orders etc. Future opinion can not be asked for.

Any information relating to any private body in any form which can be accessed by a public authority under any other law for the time being in force is under the act

Public Authority: Any authority or body or institution of self government established or constituted by or under the constitution

Or by any other law made by the Parliament

Or by a state legislature

Or by notification issued

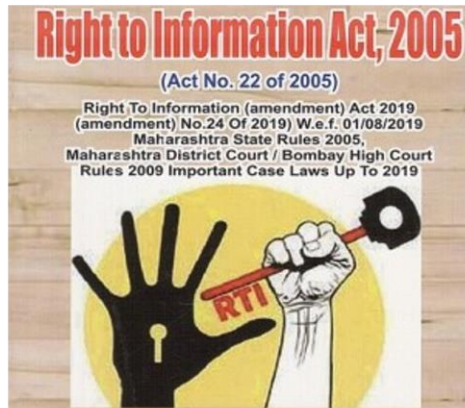
Or order made by Central Government or State Government

Transparency: Transparency of information is essential for demanding accountability.

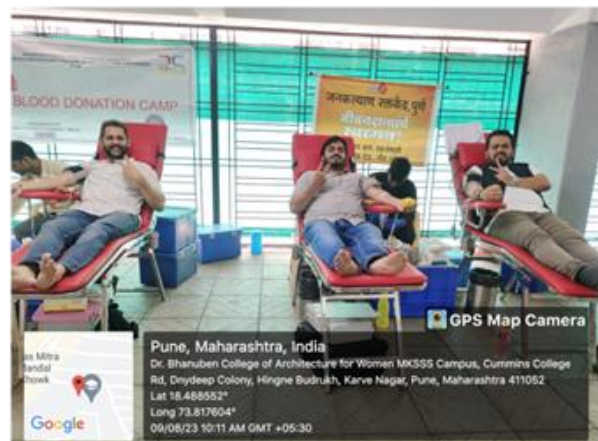

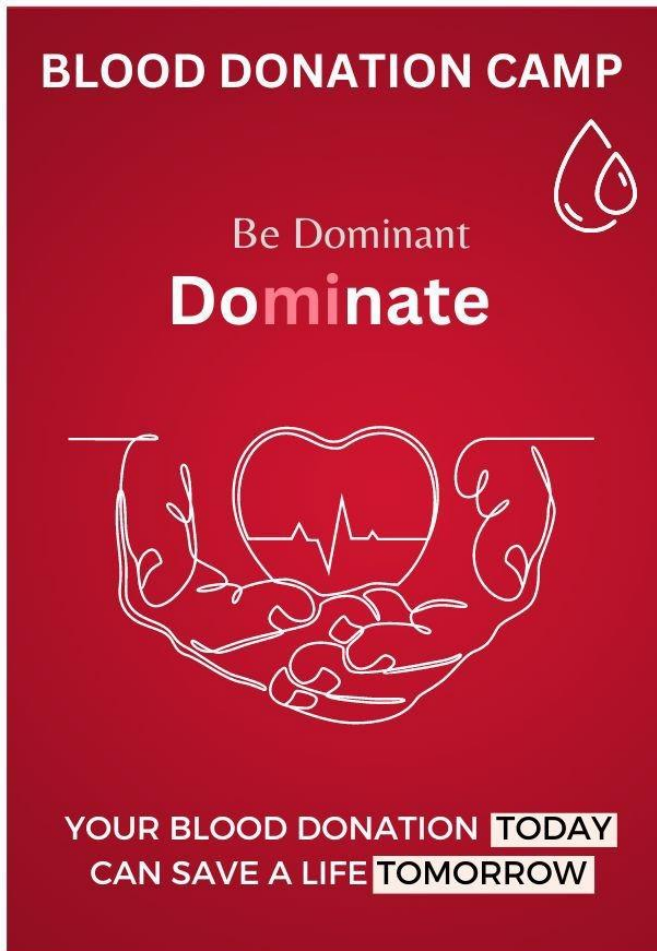
Objective of this Event:
