Equal Opportunity Cell: Introduction 2023

Dr Meera Shirolkar paid homage to father of Indian Constitution – Mahamanav- Dr B R Ambedkar for his Jayanti the next day 14th April 2023. She introduced his life in short that included his brilliant academics, contribution in making Constitution and his belief in the principles of democracy, equality, social justice and women's rights. A display of Library books was kept in the conference room by Librarian Dr Amita Pradhan, that constituted of Dr B R Ambedkar, Women's right, Social justice, etc.

Dr. Shirolkar began the session with an introduction to the Equal Opportunity Cell, emphasizing its role in ensuring inclusivity and equity in higher education as outlined by the UGC guidelines for the Promotion of Equity in Higher Educational Institutions. She explained that the EOC works to create an enabling environment for marginalized groups, including students from economically and socially disadvantaged backgrounds, differently-abled students, and others who face systemic barriers in accessing education.

The team members of the EOC were introduced during the session, and their specific roles and responsibilities were explained. The objectives of the cell, including fostering a sense of belonging, providing necessary facilities, and enabling equal access to opportunities, were elaborated upon.

Dr. Shirolkar also discussed in detail the various schemes and facilities available for marginalized students, such as:



- Scholarships and financial aid programs
- Skill enhancement, Remedial coaching and mentoring
- Accessible infrastructure for differently-abled students
- Guidance on availing government and institutional benefits

Students were encouraged to actively reach out to EOC members for guidance, discussions, or any information related to equity and inclusion. The team assured students of their full support and availability to address any concerns.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where students could seek clarification and share their thoughts. The orientation successfully underscored the commitment of the institution to fostering a supportive and inclusive learning environment.





Cultural Activities at BNCA














Kaladhaar, Karandak and Poetry Club at BNCA















Newsletters at BNCA






