Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) was launched by the Ministry of Education in 2014. The program was developed with a vision to “*transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India.*”

The Mission of UBA is “*to enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth*”.

BNCA decided to take part in this program with an aim to enable our students to engage in socially relevant activities and understand the issues faced in rural areas. **BNCA was accepted in this program in march 2019 and we received funds on 28th march 2019.** The actual work started post July 2019, when we conducted initial meetings with the sarpanch. We have been active in this program for the last three years. 5 villages in the peripheral areas of the city were identified. We also collaborated with an NOG “Green Thumbs” who have already been active in some of these villages. The following faculty are directly involved in the program: Dr. Sujata Karve (coordinator), Prof. Vaishali Anagal (coordinator), Prof. Nikita Gurav and Prof. Sayali Kulkarni. @75 students were also involved in this activity.

The activities undertaken under this are as follows:

Conducting meetings with Village heads

Conducting Gram Sabha with various members of the village to understand their issues, problems and possible solutions

Conducting a household survey in the villages

Preparing a report of the same.

Currently we are in the process of preparing a Village development plan for all the villages.

We also conducted an awareness program regarding NEP in September 2020 for all the villagers (report attached below)



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

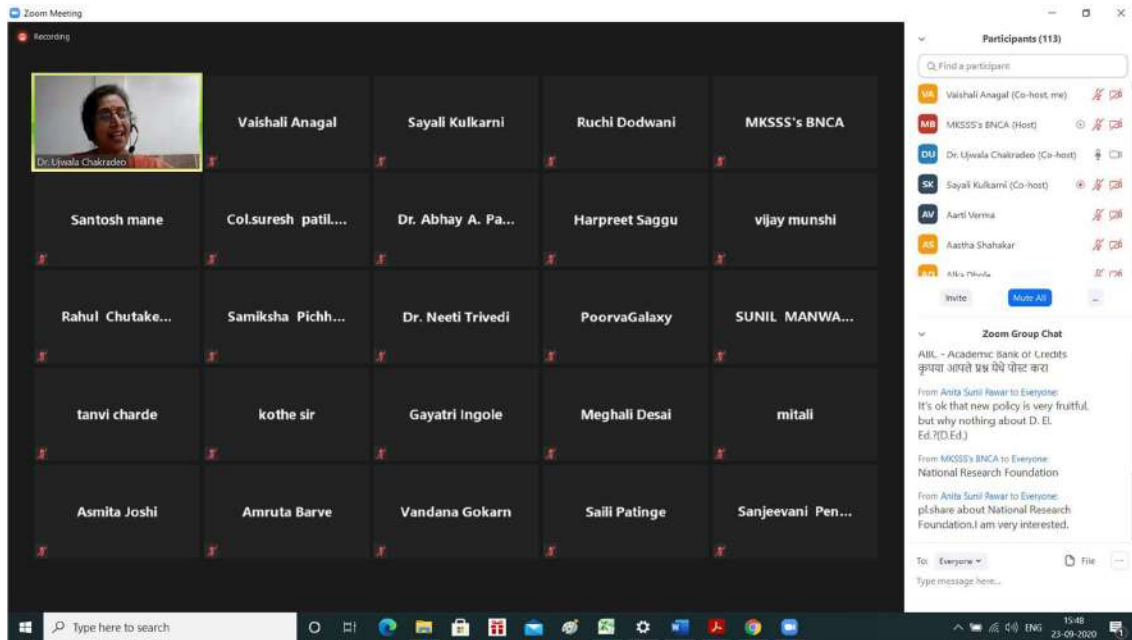
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Attendance for the NEP sensitisation program held online.

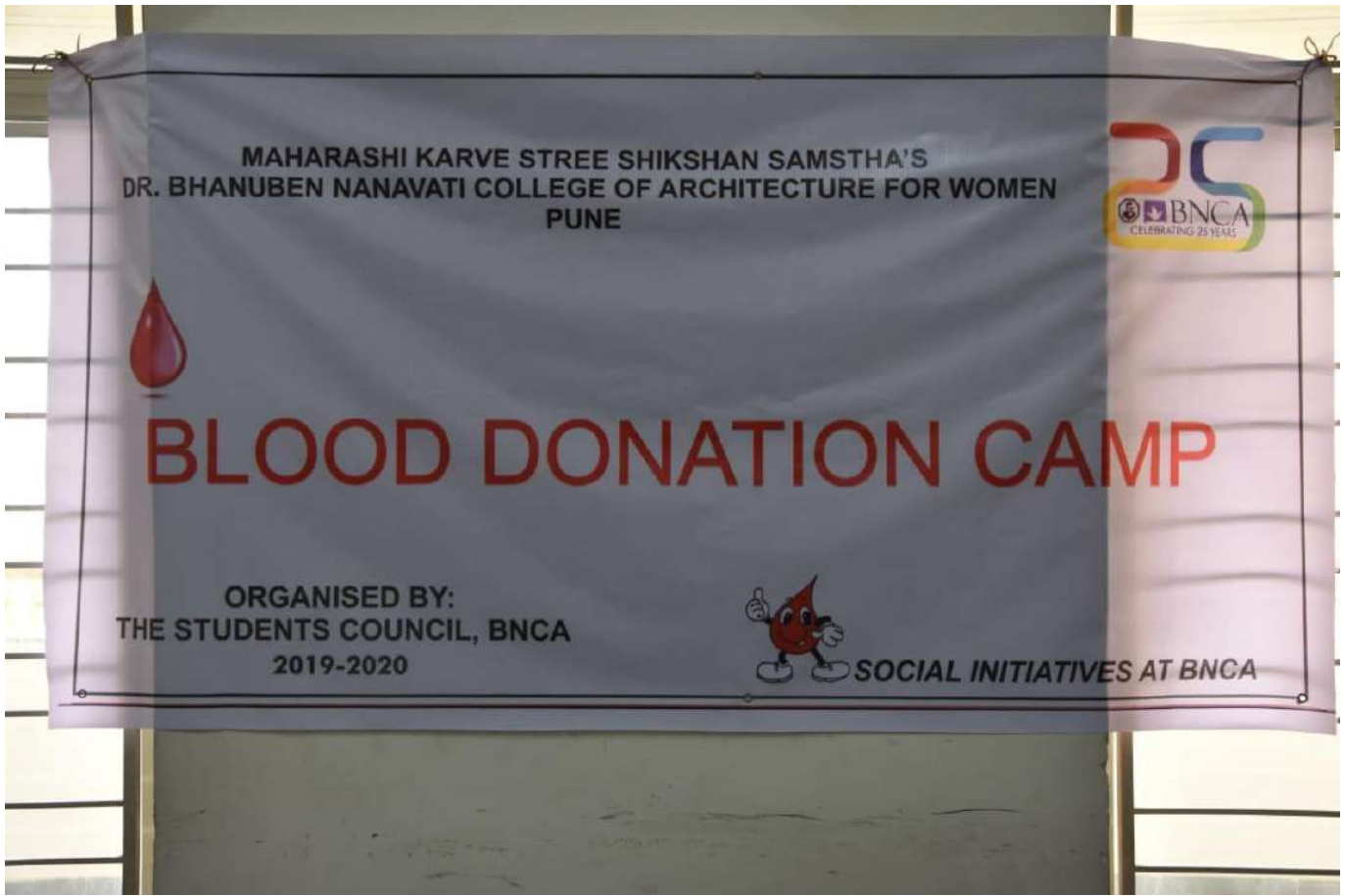
