ONLINE 10 day short term course on research methodology organised by
Ph.D. Research Center, MKSS's, Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati College of Architecture for Women, Pune
(Affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University)

This course aims to provide an overview of scientific research, identifying problems, formulating research questions, and introducing learners to frame their research design. It includes collecting data, techniques of data analyses, and interpreting results through a systematic research paradigm that shapes architectural research. Scientific research is an iterative process of observation, rationalization, and validation, while science is knowledge represented as a collection of "theories" derived using the scientific method. The purpose of theory is to explain, describe, analyze, and predict phenomena to aid understanding. This course explains the role theory plays in research work.

The experts will discuss basic concepts related to research methods, research strategies, data collection methods, sampling, and literature review. The learning outcome envisaged that the participants should be able to establish linkages between theories, social research practice, and methodology. Equip them to demonstrate a critical understanding of the range of research techniques employed by researchers, both qualitative and quantitative. It introduces the use of statistical software to analyze the data.

The course would use a combination of in-class lectures and exercises to help participants complement their theoretical knowledge by dealing with datasets, data analysis software, and data analytical techniques.

Architectural research implicates human subjects or contributors rears distinctive and multifaceted ethical, legitimate, communal, and administrative concerns. The basic rules of research ethics that govern the standards of conduct for scientific researchers will be discussed. The 10-day workshop will culminate with participant's proposal writing and discussion with the mentors aiming to develop the ability to write an academic article in the architecture domain based on quantitative data and quantitative analysis.

Emergency evacuation is the urgent immediate escape of people away from an area that contains an imminent threat, an ongoing threat or a hazard to lives or property. Emergency evacuation plans are developed to ensure the safest and most efficient evacuation time of all expected residents of a structure, city, or region. The first decision during a workplace emergency is whether the occupants should stay inside or evacuate the building. Any danger inside the building, from fire to a toxic chemical spill, necessitate an immediate evacuation. To ensure occupants safe arrival outside the building best practice is to have a clearly defined and well practiced evacuation plan in place.

As per NBC – 2016 – 'Fire and Life safety' along with Occupational Safety and Health Administration- OSHA recommends that all institutions must prepare an Emergency Action Plan and the plan that include detailed procedures for evacuation.

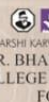

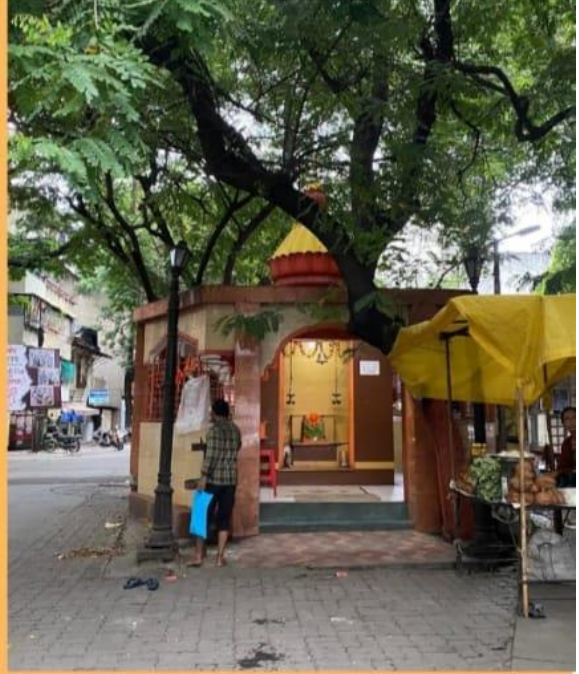

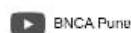
About the speaker
